






4) In the search bar, enter “Philo-Celtic” and click the search button.



12) To join individual classes, you will need to follow the procedure for each individual class. For example, to join “Starting To Learn for Absolute Beginners,” you will need to click the link in the email, scroll down the landing page and click “Join This Group.” You will also need to make sure your email preferences are organized for each group, depending on your preferences.

13) If you have joined multiple groups, your Groups.io homepage will list each of the groups that you have joined. This is the fastest way to ensure that you are correctly enrolled in the course you have chosen. If you are unable to find that information on your homepage, the “Your Groups” drop-down menu will provide quick access to all the groups to which you belong.

Frequently Asked Questions

1) I am not receiving any emails from The Philo-Celtic Society! Help!

There are several things to check. First, let's make sure you are a member of the Groups.io group and make sure that your email settings are set to "Individual Emails." Second, let's check your spam folder to make sure that your emails have not been misdirected. Finally, please contact our Publicity Secretary, who can confirm whether or not you are appropriately enrolled and help you troubleshoot.

2) How will I receive the Zoom coordinates for my class?

Each teacher organizes his or her own virtual classroom. Many choose to use Zoom. Others may choose to use other services, such as Google Meet. All teachers will provide details about how to access your class via Groups.io. If you have not received the information about how your class will meet, contact your teacher via Groups.io.

3) I am not sure which class to join!

Our classes are all organized by level and subject matter. When in doubt, try it out! If the level is too advanced for you or not advanced enough, there remain many other options!

4) How can I give back to The Philo-Celtic Society and help spread the Irish language?

We're glad you asked. There are so many ways to get involved. You have already taken one of the most important steps by choosing to learn the language.
